Once the deadline has passed and all entries are received, a survey will be sent out for the members to select the new name of our publication. The survey of suggestions will be open until JUNE 5, 2020. If there is a need for a second vote, the survey will be sent out by June 10, 2020 and be open until July 1, 2020.

Due to the 60th Annual Convention cancellation due to Covid-19, the winner will be announced in a recorded message posted on our website and social media, an announcement in the Multiple Messages sent out once results are complete, and the member who submitted the winning entry will be highlighted in the next issue of what is currently Notebook!
