Joscelyn Ramos Campbell, the keynote speaker for convention 2023, hasn't been afraid to Dream BIG as a parent, a professional, and a disability advocate.

Born in Brooklyn, New York to Cuban and Puerto Rican parents, Joscelyn is bilingual and bicultural. She is the creator of [Mami of Multiples](#), an award-winning parenting and lifestyle website, and the owner of [Mami Innovative Media](#), a communications business involved in branding campaigns and national media management. As a recognized multimedia pioneer, she hosts a blog, is the co-host of [Chicas Chatting podcast](#), and was recently named as one of "The 10 Best Latina Mommy Bloggers on the Web," by Latina Magazine and as one of the "Top Bloggers in the Business," by CBS News.



Joscelyn uses her podcast, blog and website to share tips and resources for everyday living and parenting-related challenges, including suggestions for meeting the unique needs of children diagnosed with autism and other disabilities.

Joscelyn and her husband, a military veteran of Irish American descent, are raising a multicultural and multigenerational family. They have four boys; the oldest in college, identical twins in junior high; and the youngest, who has autism, in kindergarten.

As a parent of twins, Joscelyn is a supporter of multiples clubs, often recommending that other parents of multiples find the nearest local club and get involved. She is a former member of Fairfax County Mothers of Multiples (VA), and Greater Orlando Mothers of Twins and Triplets (FL), and is currently an affiliate member of Multiples of America.

Being selected as the keynote speaker for this convention "is indeed a full circle moment for me," Joscelyn shared, "as I was so positively influenced by my experiences being in a multiples group from the time I was pregnant with my twins."

Through her keynote address, Joscelyn plans to celebrate the character, courage, and commitment of parents of multiples.

Joscelyn is also the co-founder of Hope Torchlighters, a nonprofit organization that helps to provide support, stability wellness, advocacy, and empowerment to special needs and neurodiverse families in Groveland, Lake County, and Central Florida.
