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Education Tales

Dr. John Mascazine, Associate Professor of Education at Ohio Dominican University in Columbus, OH and a researcher in the field of twin education for 30 years, shares information about navigating the school and learning experience with multiples.

Dr. Mascazine notes many parents struggle with the question of whether or not to place multiples in the same classroom. He maintains decisions should be “flexible, informed and data-driven,” emphasizing that each set of multiples is unique. He suggests several resources from the website, www.twineducation.com, can assist parents and educators in making that decision and other determinations about the education of their multiples. *All materials on the website are free to download, use, and copy.*

Those resources included:

- Checklists concerning school placement, language development and competition between multiples.
- Information about school policy for twins and higher order multiples
- Information on common themes that span across the lifespan, such as individual interests and identity, and competition vs. cooperation
- Information about zygosity of twins
